



Dave Wattenbarger Scholarship Criteria

Dave Wattenbarger was an Extension Educator in Boundary County for many years. With his retirement in 2000 donations were made to honor the 4-H program. Dave wanted these funds to be used to benefit the 4-H members of Boundary County. The Boundary County 4-H Leaders Association voted to establish a scholarship of \$50.00 per year for seven years to assist some 4-H member in attending a 4-H sponsored activity such as 4-H Camp, Teen Conference, Know Your Government, 4-H Focus, Natural Resources Camp, District Events, 4-H Horse Activities, etc.

The scholarship will be awarded annually for seven years beginning in 2003 in the amount of \$50.00. The 4-H member must apply for this scholarship using the Dave Wattenbarger application form and meet the deadlines established for that year. A 4-H member may not receive this scholarship more than once.

Criteria and selection for the scholarship will be based on the following:

1. 4-H Involvement
2. Application Form
3. Leader Recommendation (cannot be a parent)

Selection will be made by the 4-H Awards Committee and the Extension staff.
