

☘ Day Camp Schedule ☘

June 10: Sudoku Quilt Pillows (Ages 9-14) (9 am - 1pm) Come and put a Sudoku pattern pillow top together. Participants will learn how to make the 9x9 square pattern, sew it into one large piece and then put it into a pillow. Held at the Canyon County Extension Office. Bring a sack lunch.

June 11: Gone Fishing! (Ages 8-13) (9am - 2pm) Learn the basics of bait fishing and then put those skills to the test fishing on a pond. Held at Pacific Press Publishing (1350 N. Kings Road, Nampa.) Bring a sack lunch.

June 12: Archery (Ages 8-12) (9am -12 pm) Take advantage of learning about archery from a 4-H Shooting Sports Certified volunteer. Learn about archery safety, and test your new found skills target shooting a bow and arrow. Held at Whittenberger Park (W. Chicago, Caldwell).

June 15: Herbal How -To (Ages 9-14) (9am -12pm) Herbs play powerful and varied rolls in our lives; from the garden to the dinner table, medicine cabinet and even home décor. In this packed session campers will explore and learn about different herbs and their functions by making herbal vinegars, bath salts and scented sachet. Held at the Canyon County Extension Office.

June 16 & 17: Legos Come Alive (Ages 9-14) (9am - 1:30 pm) Put your imagination to the test! Work as a team to build different robots using Legos. Kids will learn how to build, program and work as a team to complete their robot. This camp is two days long. Held at the Canyon County Extension Office. Bring a sack lunch.

June 18: Gone Fishing! (Ages 8-13) (9am -2pm) Learn the basics of bait fishing and then put those skills to the test fishing on a pond. Held at Whittenberger Park. (W. Chicago , Caldwell) Bring a sack lunch.

June 23: Exploring Food and Fun in 4-H (Ages 5-8) (9am -12pm) Kids 5-8 years old, this day camp is for you! Come have fun with a variety of activities including creating healthy snacks, art projects, games, and a few more surprises. Held at the Canyon County Extension Office.

June 24: First Aid Basics (Ages 8-14) (9am -3pm) Bumps, bruises, cuts - What do you do? Come learn about basic first aid, what supplies to have handy and when you need to call for help. You will also create and take home your own first aid kit! Held at the Canyon County Extension Office. Bring a sack lunch.

June 25: Creative Cards (Ages 8-12) (9am - 12pm) Do you like to give your family and friends cards for special occasions? If so, this is the class for you. Come join in on the fun of making adorable greeting cards. Learn several different techniques to add a fun look to your cards. Held at the Canyon County Extension Office.

June 29: Soap Making (Ages 8-12) (9 am -12pm) How about washing with goat milk instead of drinking it? Learn the basics of soap making while making goat milk soap. Held at the Canyon County Extension Office.



July 2: Photo Fun for Everyone! (Ages 8-14) (9am -2pm) Learn about composition and light, to take pictures from every angle, and functions of a camera. Activities will include a photo scavenger hunt, building a stick frame, and creating a scrapbook page or card. Held at Lakeview Park, Nampa. (Garrity Blvd. and 16th Ave. , Nampa) Bring a sack lunch.

July 7: Science in the Kitchen (Ages 12-16) (9am -2pm) Learn about how you use and eat chemistry every day. Perform science experiments to discuss what happens, mix and make actual food items to identify how chemistry makes cookies rise, ice cream form and other fun activities. Held at the Canyon County Extension Office. Bring a sack lunch.

July 8: Babysitting Basics (Ages 12-16) (9am -3pm) You're ready to go out into the world and babysit or you've been left in charge of your younger siblings. Come learn about caring for children of different ages, making nutritious snacks and handling emergency situations. Held at College of Western Idaho (2407 Caldwell Blvd., Nampa). Bring a sack lunch.

July 9: Leather Craft (Ages 10-12) (9am-12 pm) Learn about where leather comes from, types of leather, and how it is processed for use. You will learn to use the basic 7 tools of leather tooling, complete a leather project, and a mystery braiding project. Held at the College of Western Idaho (2407 Caldwell Blvd., Nampa).

July 10: Cards For All Reasons! (Ages 8-16) (9 am -12pm) Create fun thank you, birthday, and seasonal cards using a variety of card making techniques. Come learn about stamping, embossing, stickles and more techniques to create greeting cards to give to your friends and family. Held at the College of Western Idaho (2407 Caldwell Blvd., Nampa).
