If you are going to show an animal in Canyon County it must be weighed in at the Canyon County initial weigh-in. If you are going to show an animal in Ada County it must be weighed in at the Ada County initial weigh-in.

SHEEP*	Tuesday, July 21, 5 PM to 8 PM Canyon County Fair Grounds	**Minimum weight of 110 lbs 70 days feed period
MARKET GOAT*	Tuesday, July 21, 5 PM to 8 PM Canyon County Fair Grounds	** Minimum weight of 65 lbs 70 days feed period

Please be aware that mortality insurance fees will be collected at initial weigh-in instead of being taken out of checks at the end of the season. They will be collected on the first animal weighed in that species. Beef: \$20 (Insurance \$12, Office \$5, Judge \$3) 2nd beef \$8 (Office \$5, Judge \$3) Swine/Sheep: \$10 (Insurance \$4, Office \$3, Judge \$3) each additional animal \$6 (Office \$3, Judge \$3) Goat: \$8 (Insurance \$2, Office \$3, Judge \$3) each additional goat \$6 (Office \$3, Judge\$3)

*Animals brought to fair must be on official fair entry form.

**Animals that do not make the minimum weights may be entered in the feeder class or taken home.

~~Swine that exceed the maximum weight and backfat will not sell (may be shown in heavy weight class)

~~Decision to take home must be made immediately after weigh-in.

BEEF - \$11.00 per head (\$5 for Meat Quality Fund)	Saturday, March 21 9 to 11 a.m. Fairgrounds (calves are to be halter broke)	<u>Open weight</u> 152 days feed period
SWINE - \$4.00 per head (\$2 for Meat Quality Fund)	Thursday, May 14 4 to 7 p.m. Fairgrounds	<u>100 lbs. maximum</u> 100 days feed period
SHEEP - \$4.00 per head (\$2 for Meat Quality Fund)	Thursday, May 21 4 to 7 p.m. Fairgrounds	<u>85 lbs. maximum</u> 91 days feed period

FINAL WEIGH-IN SCHEDULE

Species - Limit of 2 head per youth	Date, Time, Location	To Show/Sell at Western Idaho Fair
BEEF*	Thursday, August 20 4:00 to 5:00 p.m. Fairgrounds	1,000 lbs. minimum **
SWINE*	Thursday, August 20 5:30 to 8:00 p.m. Fairgrounds	230 lbs. minimum ** 280 lbs. maximum ** 281-300 lbs. maximum***
SHEEP*	Thursday, August 20 5:30 to 8:00 p.m. Fairgrounds	110 lbs. minimum ** Lambs that prolapse will not be al- lowed on grounds or to sell.****

*Animals brought to fair must be on entry form, you may enter all animals from initial weigh-in, but only bring 2.

**Animals not meeting weight requirements will not sell.

Note: Each exhibitor can sell only one (1) market animal of any market species.

Animals who do not make minimum weights may be taken home the night of entry.

***Swine weighing between 281-300 will only be allowed to sell if sale committee can find a buyer for these heavy weight swine.

****It is recommended that the sheep tail be docked at the distal end of the caudal fold in accordance with the AVMA guidelines.

Entry deadline for WIF is July 31st
