The funds are invested with the Canyon County 4-H Endowment Fund, which is vested with the University of Idaho Consolidated Investment Trust (CIT). Only the earned interest is used each year for program support. A Board of Directors sets guidelines for the funds and no salaries are paid from the fund.
