This six-week workshop teaches individuals how to build, manage and achieve personal financial success. Each week focuses on a different topic:

- Week 1 - Building a Livable Spending Plan;
- Week 2 - Credit Everything;
- Week 3 - Managing Money and Debt;
- Week 4 - Protecting Your Personal Identity;
- Week 5 - Renting Your First Home; and
- Week 6 - Buying Your First Car.

This family-focused educational program teaches how to transfer personal property. Personal property transfer is an issue frequently ignored until a crisis occurs and immediate decisions need to be made. The program stresses six key factors for successful non-titled property transfers.

This real-life simulation gives young people (pre-teen to 20-something) a glimpse of the future in a fun way. It introduces them to basic skills of financial planning, decision making, and goal setting, motivates them to examine their future careers and goals, and reinforces why it is so important to stay in school.

Credit Card BINGO

A fun way to learn about credit. Participants at this "event" will gain valuable information on how to wisely find and apply for credit and how that credit will affect their financial future. With the increase of debt and credit usage in our Nation, it is important to know the "basics" of credit, credit applications, credit terms and conditions, and the consequences of not knowing this information. This is also a great forum for in-depth conversations surrounding credit (including credit scores and credit reports) and debt management (including solutions and prevention) and encourages participants to share personal stories and concerns along the way.

Pressure Canner Gauge Testing

Pressure canners with a dial gauge should be tested yearly for accuracy before you begin your canning process. Pressure canning is the only recommended method for canning meat, poultry, seafood, and vegetables. I offer **free pressure canning clinics** throughout the canning season and **drop-off testing** (24-hour turn-around) at the Extension office for **\$2.00 per gauge**.
